Proverbs 1:2-4 AT

- 2 to learn wisdom and discipline, to understand words of insight
- 3 to acquire the discipline of good judgment, righteousness, justice, and fairness
- 4 to give prudence to the naïve, knowledge and discretion to the young





Proverbs 1:5-6 AT

- 5 the wise will listen and increase in learning,the one who understands will get guidance6 to understand proverb and parable,
- the sayings of the wise and their riddles





Proverbs 1:7 AT

The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge, but fools despise wisdom and discipline







The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom,

and knowledge of the Holy One is understanding (Pr 9:10, NIV)

Charm is deceptive, and beauty is fleeting;

but a woman who fears the LORD is to be praised (Pr 31:30, NIV)







- The reward for humility and fear of the LORD
 - is riches and honor and life (Pr 22:4, ESV)
- The fear of the LORD adds length to life,
 - but the years of the wicked are cut short (Pr 10:27, NIV)
- The fear of the LORD is a fountain of life,
 - turning a person from the snares of death (Pr 14:27, NIV)
- The fear of the LORD leads to life;
 - then one rests content, untouched by trouble. (Pr 19:23, NIV)





Deuteronomy 6:5 AT

Love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might.





Deuteronomy 10:12 NIV

And now, Israel, what does the LORD your God ask of you but to **fear the LORD** your God, to walk in **obedience** to him, to **love** him, to **serve** the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul





John 14:15 NIV

If you love me, keep my commands





Exodus 8:1 NIV

Then the LORD said to Moses, "Go to Pharaoh and say to him, 'This is what the LORD says: Let my people go, so that they may worship me.





Exodus 20:1-2 NIV

Foolish vs. Wise

- The wise in heart accept commands,
 - but a chattering fool comes to ruin (Pr 10:8, NIV)
- Even fools are thought wise if they keep silent,
 - and discerning if they hold their tongues. (Pr 17:28, NIV)
- Fools find no pleasure in understanding
 - but delight in airing their own opinions. (Pr 18:2, NIV)





Proverbs 12:15 NIV

The way of **fools** seems right to them, but the **wise** listen to advice.





Ephesians 6:4 ESV

Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger, but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord





Proverbs 3:13-15 NIV

- 13 Blessed are those who find wisdom, those who gain understanding,
- 14 for she is more profitable than **silver** and yields better returns than **gold**.
- 15 She is more precious than rubies; nothing you desire can compare with her.





Proverbs 3:16-18 NIV

- 16 Long life is in her right hand; in her left hand are riches and honor.
- 17 Her ways are pleasant ways, and all her paths are peace.
- 18 She is a **tree of life** to those who take hold of her; those who hold her fast will be **blessed**.





Proverbs 4:6 NIV

Do not forsake wisdom, and she will **protect** you; love her, and she will **watch over** you





Proverbs 3:5-6 NIV

5 Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding;6 in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight





Proverbs 3:7-8 NIV
