



2 Timothy 4:1-5 NIV

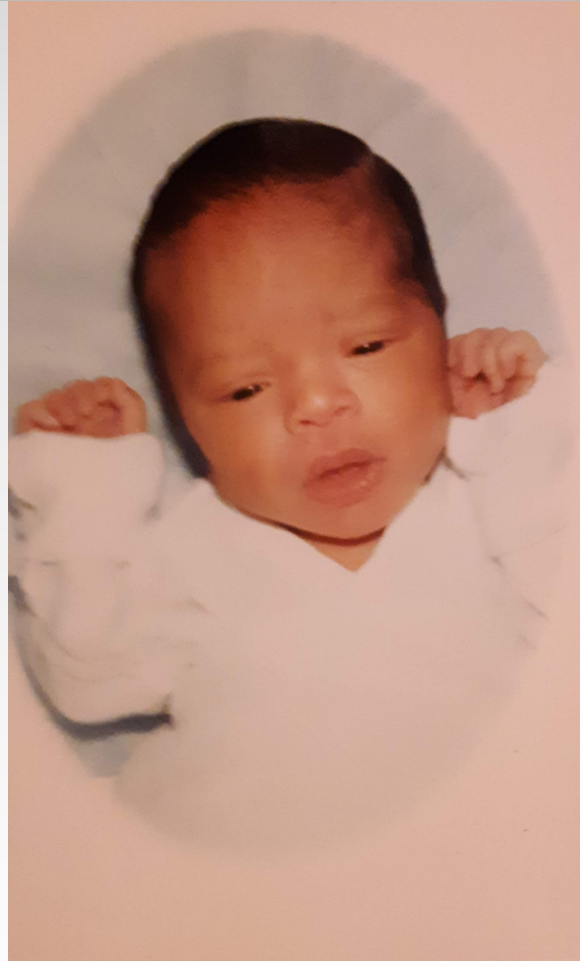

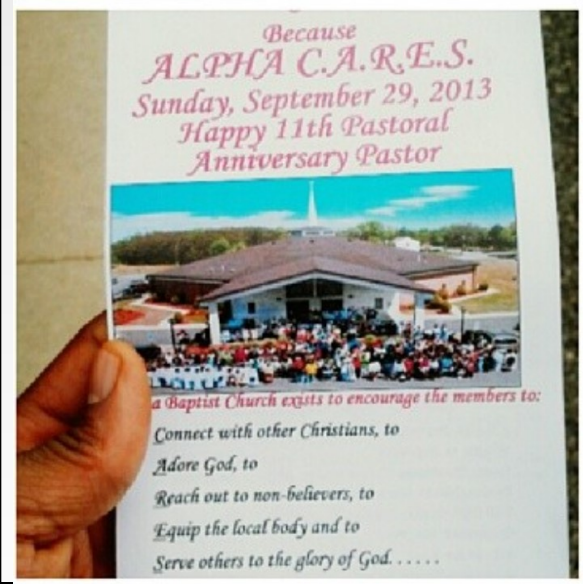

Titus 1:9 NIV
