JOHN 4:35-42 LESSON | DANNY SCOTTON JR.



CONTEXT JOHN 4:27-34



- 27 And just then, His disciples came and were astonished that He was speaking with a woman – though no one asked, "What is it that you seek?" or "Why do you speak with her?" 28 Then, she left her water jar and went into the city. And she says to the men: 29 Come! See a man who told me everything I ever did. This couldn't be the Messiah, could it? 30 They went out of the city and were coming to Him.
- 31 In the meantime, the disciples were begging him, saying: "Rabbi, [please] eat [something]." 32 But He said to them, "I have food to eat that you don't know [about]." 33 Then the disciples began saying to each other, "No one brought Him [something] to eat, did they?" 34 Jesus says to them, "My food is that I should do the will of Him who sent me and finish His work." (Jn 4:27-34 AT)



JOHN 4:35 HARVEST TIME



 Doesn't the saying go, "There are yet four months; then comes the harvest?" Look, I say to you, lift up your eyes and behold the fields that are ripe for harvest. (already) (Jn 4:35,AT)



JOHN 4:36 GODLY GARDENING



- Already, the one who harvests receives pay and gathers fruit for eternal life, so that the one who sows may rejoice together [with] the one who harvests. (Jn 4:36,AT)
- 37 Then he said to his disciples, "The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. 38 Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field." (Mt 9:37-38, NIV)
- 6 I planted the seed, Apollos watered it, but God has been making it grow. 7 So neither the one who plants nor the one who waters is anything, but only God, who makes things grow (I Cor 3:6-7, NIV)
- "No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws them, and I will raise them up at the last day" (Jn 6:44, NIV).



JOHN 4:37 FRUITS OF LABOR



- For in this the saying is true, "One is the one who sows and another is the one who harvests." (Jn 4:37,AT)
- I hated all the things I had toiled for under the sun, because I must leave them to the one who comes after me. (Ec 2:18, NIV)



JOHN 4:38 TEAMWORK MAKES THE DREAM WORK



- I sent you to harvest that for which you did not labor. Others labored and you, because of their labor, have benefited. (Jn 4:38,AT)
- Now Jesus learned that the Pharisees had heard that he was gaining and baptizing more disciples than John—2 although in fact it was not Jesus who baptized, but his disciples. (Jn 4:1-2, NIV)
- Again Jesus said, "Peace be with you! As the Father has **sent** me, I am **sending** you." (Jn 20:21, NIV)
- 28 You yourselves can testify that I said, 'I am not the Messiah but am sent ahead of him.' 29 The bride belongs to the bridegroom. The friend who attends the bridegroom waits and listens for him, and is full of joy when he hears the bridegroom's voice. That joy is mine, and it is now complete. 30 He must become greater; I must become less." (Jn 3:28-30, NIV)



JOHN 4:39 A WINSOME WITNESS



- Many of the Samaritans from that city believed in Him on account of the word of the woman testifying, "He told me everything I did." (Jn 4:39,AT)
- 20 He went on: "What comes out of a person is what defiles them. 21 For it is from within, out of a person's heart, that evil thoughts come—sexual immorality, theft, murder, 22 adultery, greed, malice, deceit, lewdness, envy, slander, arrogance and folly. 23 All these evils come from inside and defile a person." (Mk 7:20-23, NIV).
- Whoever **believes in** the Son has eternal life, but whoever rejects the Son will not see life, for God's wrath remains on them. (Jn 3:36, NIV)
- 19 You believe that there is one God. Good! Even the demons believe that—and shudder. (Jas 2:19, NIV)
- II Whenever the impure spirits saw him, they fell down before him and cried out, "You are the Son of God. (Mk 3:11, NIV)



JOHN 4:40 SEEDS IN SAMARIA



- So, when the Samaritans came to Him, they were begging Him to stay with them. And He remained there two days. (Jn 4:40, AT)
- 4 Remain in me, as I also remain in you. No branch can bear fruit by itself; it must remain in the vine. Neither can you bear fruit unless you remain in me. 5 "I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing. (Jn 15:4-5, NIV).
- 4 Those who had been scattered preached the word wherever they went. 5 Philip went down to a city in Samaria and proclaimed the Messiah there. 6 When the crowds heard Philip and saw the signs he performed, they all paid close attention to what he said. 7 For with shrieks, impure spirits came out of many, and many who were paralyzed or lame were healed. 8 So there was great joy in that city. (Ac 8:4-8, NIV)
- 14 When the apostles in Jerusalem heard that **Samaria** had **accepted the word of God**, they sent Peter and John to **Samaria**. 15 When they arrived, they prayed for the new believers there that they might receive the Holy Spirit, 16 because the Holy Spirit had not yet come on any of them; they had simply been baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. 17 Then Peter and John placed their hands on them, and they received the Holy Spirit. (Ac 8:14-17, NIV)



JOHN 4:41 STRAIGHT FROM THE SOURCE



• And many more believed on account of His word. (Jn 4:41,AT)



JOHN 4:42 FIRSTHAND FAITH



- And to the woman, they said, "No longer do we believe on account of what you said, because we ourselves have heard and we know that this man is truly the savior of the world." (Jn 4:42, AT)
- 25 The woman said, "I know that Messiah" (called Christ) "is coming. When he comes, he will explain everything to us." 26 Then Jesus declared, "I, the one speaking to you—I am he." (Jn 4:25-26, NIV)
- 3 The gatekeeper opens the gate for him, and the sheep listen to his voice. He calls his own sheep by name and leads them out. 4 When he has brought out all his own, he goes on ahead of them, and his sheep follow him because they know his voice. (Jn 10:3-4, NIV)
- I4 "I am the good shepherd; I know my sheep and my sheep know me—I5 just as the Father knows me and I know the Father—and I lay down my life for the sheep. (Jn 10:14-15, NIV)
- I0 But the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid. I bring you good news that will cause great joy for all the people. I I Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; he is the Messiah, the Lord. (Lk 2:10-11, NIV)



JOHN 4:42 SAVIOR OF THE WORLD



- 22 You Samaritans worship what you do not know; we worship what we do know, for salvation is from the Jews. (Jn 4:22, NIV)
- 19 Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age." (Mt 28:19-20, NIV)
- I6 For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. I7 For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him. (Jn 3:16-17, NIV)



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
