

How long will you hide your face from me?


2 **How long** must I wrestle with my thoughts

O give **thanks** unto the LORD, for he is good:


For his mercy endureth for ever. (Ps 107:1, KJV)



PSALM I WISDOM PSALM




For the wisdom of this world is foolishness in God's sight. (I Cor 3:19a, NIV)

PSALM I:I PARALLELISM




I The heavens declare the glory of God;

praise him in his mighty heavens. (Ps 150:1, NIV)




PSALM I:I PARALLEL PROGRESSION

or stand in the way of sinners,


or dwell in the assembly of mockers (Ps I:I,AT)



PSALM I:I WALKING THE WRONG WAY



- They claim to know God, but by their actions they deny him. (Tit I:16a, NIV)
- Whoever claims to live in him must live as Jesus did. (1 Jn 2:6, NIV)
- Whoever says, "I know him," but does not do what he commands is a liar, and the truth is not in that person. (I Jn 2:4, NIV)



PSALM 1:1 MOCKERS



7 Whoever corrects a **mocker** invites insults;

whoever rebukes the wicked incurs abuse.


8 Do not rebuke **mockers** or they will hate you;

rebuke the wise and they will love you. (Pr 9:7-8, NIV)

34 He mocks proud mockers


but shows favor to the humble and oppressed. (Pr 3:34, NIV)

PSALM I:I TRUE BLISS




Whoever gives heed to instruction prospers,

Blessed are those whose ways are blameless,


who walk according to the law of the LORD. (Ps 119:1, NIV)

- II "Blessed are you when people insult you, persecute you and falsely say all kinds of evil against you because of me. I2 Rejoice and be glad, because great is your reward in heaven, for in the same way they persecuted the prophets who were before you." (Mt 5:11-12, NIV)
- Remember what I told you: 'A servant is not greater than his master.' If they persecuted me, they will persecute you also. (Jn 15:20a, NIV)



PSALM 1:2 LAW, INSTRUCTIONS DIRECTIONS




but rather in the law of the LORD they delight;

She speaks with wisdom,


and faithful instruction [torah] is on her tongue. (Pr 31:26, NIV)



PSALM 1:2 MEDITATE ON THE LORD'S INSTRUCTIONS




- He said to them, "This is what I told you while I was still with you: Everything must be fulfilled that is written about me in the **Law of Moses**, the **Prophets** and the **Psalms**." (Lk 24:44, NIV)
- Keep this Book of the Law [torah] always on your lips; meditate on it day
 and night, so that you may be careful to do everything written in it. Then you
 will be prosperous and successful. (Jos 1:8, NIV)
- "Remember the law [torah] of my servant Moses, the decrees and laws
 [torah] I gave him at Horeb for all Israel. (Mal 4:4, NIV)



PSALM 1:2 MEDITATE ON THE LORD'S INSTRUCTIONS



- Thy word have I hid in mine heart, That I might not sin against thee. (Ps I 19:11, KJV)
- 97 Oh, how I love your law [torah]!
 - I meditate on it all day long.

103 How sweet are your words to my taste,


sweeter than honey to my mouth!

PSALM 1:3 GODLY PROSPERITY



And they are like a tree (trans)planted by streams of water;

which gives fruit in its season;

and whose leaf does not wither;


whatever they do prospers (Ps 1:3,AT)

PSALM 1:3 PROSPERITY GOSPEL?




35 "Who has ever given to God,

PSALM 1:4 GONE WITH THE WIND



Not so the wicked;

but rather, they are like chaff that the wind blows away (Ps 1:4, AT).

But your many enemies will become like fine dust,

the ruthless hordes like blown chaff. (Is 29:5ab, NIV)


His winnowing fork is in his hand, and he will clear his **threshing** floor, **gathering his wheat into the barn** and **burning up the chaff** with **unquenchable fire**." (Mt 3:12, NIV)



PSALM 1:5 CAN'T STAND IT



Therefore the wicked will not stand in the judgment; nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous (Ps 1:5,AT).




PSALM 1:6 TWO WAYS, TWO DESTINATIONS



For the LORD watches over the way of the righteous, but the way of the wicked will perish. (Ps 1:6,AT)


And Adam **knew** (yāda')] Eve his wife; and she conceived, and bare Cain, and said, I have gotten a man from the LORD (Gen 4:1, KJV).



PSALM 1:6 TWO WAYS, TWO DESTINATIONS




18 The blameless spend their days under the LORD's care, and their inheritance will endure forever. 19 In times of disaster they will not wither; in days of famine they will enjoy plenty. 20 But the wicked will perish: Though the LORD's enemies are like the flowers of the field, they will be consumed, they will go up in smoke. (Ps 37:18-20, NIV)



PSALM 1:6 THINK LONG-TERM



- 3 For I envied the arrogant
 - when I saw the prosperity of the wicked. (Ps 73:3, NIV)
- I Do not fret because of those who are evil or be envious of those who do wrong;
- 2 for like the grass they will soon wither,
 - like green plants they will soon die away. (Ps 37:1-2, NIV)








12 The wicked plot against the righteous

13 but the LORD laughs at the wicked,


for he knows their day is coming.



PSALM 1:6 DIVINE INTERVENTION



- 3 I The law [torah] of their God is in their hearts; their feet do not slip. (Ps 37:3 I, NIV)
- 5 Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean **not on your own understanding**;
- 6 in all your ways **submit to** (יָדַע (**yāda** ')] him, and **he will make your paths straight**. (Pr 3:5-6, NIV)



PSALM 1:6 DIVINE INTERVENTION




I I will lift up mine eyes unto the hills,

PSALM 1:6 TWO WAYS, TWO DESTINATIONS



- 5 This is what the LORD says:
- "Cursed is the one who trusts in man, who draws strength from mere flesh and whose heart turns away from the LORD.
- 6 That person will be like a **bush in the wastelands**; they **will not see prosperity** when it comes.
 - They will dwell in the **parched places of the desert**, in a salt land where no one lives.
- 7 "But **blessed** is the one who trusts in the LORD, whose confidence is in him.
- 8 They will be **like a tree planted by the water** that sends out its roots by the stream.
 - It does not fear when heat comes; its leaves are always green.
 - It has no worries in a year of drought and never fails to bear fruit." (Jer 17:5-8, NIV)



PSALM 1:6 TWO WAYS, TWO DESTINATIONS




- For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish (ἀπόλλυμι | apollymi) but have eternal life. (Jn 3:16, NIV)
- But everyone who hears these words of mine and does not put them into practice is like a foolish man who built his house on sand. (Mt 7:26, NIV)
- Then I will tell them plainly, 'I never knew you. Away from me, you evildoers!' (Mt 7:23, NIV)
- 13 "Enter through the narrow gate. For wide is the gate and **broad is the road** that leads to destruction, and many enter through it. 14 But small is the gate and narrow the road that leads to life, and only a few find it. (Mt 7:13-14, NIV)



PSALM 1:6 MAKARIOS MEDITATION



• 27 As Jesus was saying these things, a woman in the crowd called out, "Blessed [makarios] is the mother who gave you birth and nursed you." 28 He replied, "Blessed [makarios] rather are those who hear the word of God and obey it." (Lk 11:27-28, NIV)



THE LORD LISTENS TO THOSE WHO LISTEN



The LORD is far from the wicked,

but he hears the prayer of the righteous. (Pr 15:29, NIV)

The LORD detests the sacrifice of the wicked,

but the prayer of the upright pleases him. (Pr 15:8, NIV)

If anyone turns a deaf ear to my instruction [torah],

even their prayers are detestable. (Pr 28:9, NIV)
