
I. Jesus' Coming is an Answer to Prophecy Matthew 1:22 NIV


II. Jesus' Coming Identifies Who He Is Luke 4:34 NIV






Moreover, demons came out of many people, shouting, "You are the Son of God!" But he rebuked them and would not allow them to speak, because they knew he was the Messiah.

by taking the very nature of a servant,


being made in human likeness.
