



## Mark 14:12-16 NIV

---

12 On the first day of the Festival of Unleavened Bread, when it was customary to sacrifice the Passover lamb, Jesus' disciples asked him, "Where do you want us to go and make preparations for you to eat the Passover?"

13 So he sent two of his disciples, telling them, "Go into the city, and a man carrying a jar of water will meet you. Follow him. 14 Say to the owner of the house he enters, 'The Teacher asks: Where is my guest room, where I may eat the Passover with my disciples?' 15 He will show you a large room upstairs, furnished and ready. Make preparations for us there."

16 The disciples left, went into the city and found things just as Jesus had told them. So they prepared the Passover.



## Mark 14:17-21 NIV

---

17 When evening came, Jesus arrived with the Twelve. 18 While they were reclining at the table eating, he said, “Truly I tell you, one of you will betray me—one who is eating with me.”

19 They were saddened, and one by one they said to him, “Surely you don’t mean me?”

20 “It is one of the Twelve,” he replied, “one who dips bread into the bowl with me. 21 The Son of Man will go just as it is written about him. But woe to that man who betrays the Son of Man! It would be better for him if he had not been born.”



## Mark 14:22-26 NIV

---

22 While they were eating, Jesus took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it and gave it to his disciples, saying, “Take it; this is my body.”

23 Then he took a cup, and when he had given thanks, he gave it to them, and they all drank from it.

24 “This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many,” he said to them. 25 “Truly I tell you, I will not drink again from the fruit of the vine until that day when I drink it new in the kingdom of God.”

26 When they had sung a hymn, they went out to the Mount of Olives.



## Mark 14:12 AT

---

Then, on the first day of the Festival of Unleavened Bread, when they would sacrifice the Passover [lamb], His disciples asked Him, "Where do You want us to go and make preparations so that You can eat the Passover [meal]?"



## Exodus 12:7-8 NIV

---

7 Then they are to take some of the **blood** and put it on the **sides and tops of the doorframes** of the **houses** where they eat the **lambs**. 8 That same **night** they are to **eat the meat** roasted over the fire, along with **bitter herbs**, and **bread made without yeast**.



## Exodus 12:13-15a NIV

---

13 The **blood** will be a **sign for you** on the houses where you are, and when I **see the blood**, I will **pass over you**. No destructive plague will touch you when I strike Egypt. 14 “This is a **day you are to commemorate**; for the generations to come you shall celebrate it as a festival to the LORD—a lasting ordinance. 15 For seven days you are to eat **bread made without yeast**.



## Exodus 12:17 NIV

---

**“Celebrate the Festival of Unleavened Bread, because it was on this very day that I brought your divisions out of Egypt. Celebrate this day as a lasting ordinance for the generations to come.**



## Mark 14:13 AT

---

And He sends two of His disciples and says to them, "Go into the city and a man carrying a jar of water will meet you. Follow him."



## Mark 14:14-16 AT

---

14 And wherever he enters, tell the master of the house, "The Teacher says, 'Where is My guest room where I may eat the Passover [meal] with My disciples?'" 15 And He will show you a large upstairs room, furnished and ready. Make preparations for us there. 16. Then the disciples left and went into the city and found things just as He had told them. And they made preparations for the Passover.



## Mark 14:17-18 AT

---

17 And when evening came, He arrives with the Twelve. 18 While they were reclining [at the table] and eating, Jesus said, "Amen, I say to you that one of you will betray Me – one who eats with Me."



## Psalm 41:9 NIV

---

Even my close friend,  
someone I trusted,  
one who **shared my bread,**  
**has turned against me.**



## Mark 14:19 AT

---

And they began to be sorrowful and to say to Him one by one, "Surely, not I?"



## Mark 14:20 AT

---

But He said to them, "It is one of the Twelve – one who dips with Me in the dish."



## Mark 14:21 AT

---

For, the Son of Man goes just as it has been written about Him. But woe to that man by whom the Son of Man is betrayed. It would be better for him if that man had not been born.



## Mark 14:22 AT

---

And while they were eating, He took [a loaf of] bread. After He gave a blessing, He broke it and gave it to them, and said, "Take it, this is My body."



## Mark 14:23-24 AT

---

23 Then, He took a cup, and after He gave thanks, He gave it to them, and they all drank from it. 24 And He said to them, "This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many."



## Exodus 24:3-7 NIV

---

3 When Moses went and told the people all the LORD's words and laws, they responded with one voice, "Everything the LORD has said **we will do.**"

4 Moses then wrote down everything the LORD had said. He got up early the next morning and built an altar at the foot of the mountain and set up twelve stone pillars representing the twelve tribes of Israel. 5 Then he sent young Israelite men, and they offered burnt offerings and **sacrificed** young bulls as fellowship offerings to the LORD. 6 Moses took half of the **blood** and put it in bowls, and the other half he **splashed against the altar.** 7 Then he took the Book of the Covenant and read it to the people. They responded, "**We will do everything the LORD has said; we will obey.**"



## Exodus 24:8 NIV

---

Moses then took the **blood**, sprinkled it on the people and said, “This is **the blood of the covenant** that the LORD has made with you in accordance with all these words.”



## Hebrews 9:20-22 NIV

---

20 He said, “This is **the blood of the covenant**, which God has commanded you to keep.” 21 In the same way, he **sprinkled with the blood** both the **tabernacle** and **everything used in its ceremonies**. 22 In fact, the law requires that **nearly everything be cleansed with blood**, and **without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness**.



## Blood of the New Covenant

---

This is **my blood of the covenant**, which is poured out for many **for the forgiveness of sins.** (Mt 26:28, NIV)

In the same way, after the supper he took the cup, saying, “This cup is **the new covenant in my blood**, which is poured out for you. (Lk 22:20, NIV)

In the same way, after supper he took the cup, saying, “This cup is **the new covenant** in my blood; do this, whenever you drink it, in remembrance of me.” (1 Cor 11:25, NIV)



## Jeremiah 31:31-34 NIV

---

31 “The days are coming,” declares the LORD, “when I will make a **new covenant** with the people of Israel and with the people of Judah. It will **not be like the covenant** I made with **their ancestors** when I took them by the hand to **lead them out of Egypt**, because they broke my covenant, though I was a husband to them,” declares the LORD. “This is the **covenant** I will make with the people of Israel after that time,” declares the LORD. “I will put my law in their minds and write it on their hearts. I will be their God, and they will be my people. No longer will they teach their neighbor, or say to one another, ‘Know the LORD,’ because they will all know me, from the least of them to the greatest,” declares the LORD. “For I will **forgive their wickedness** and will **remember their sins no more.**”



## Mark 10:45 AT

---

For the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life – a ransom **for** [in place of] **many**



## Isaiah 53:10-11 NIV

---

- 10 Yet it was the LORD's will to crush him and cause him to suffer, and though the LORD makes his **life an offering for sin**, he will **see his offspring** and **prolong his days**, and the will of the LORD will prosper in his hand.
- 11 **After** he has suffered, he will **see the light of life** and be satisfied; by his knowledge my righteous servant will **justify many**, and he will **bear their iniquities**.



## Isaiah 53:12 NIV

---

12 Therefore I will give him a portion among the great,  
and he will divide the spoils with the strong,  
because he **poured out his life unto death,**  
and was numbered with the transgressors.  
For he **bore the sin of many,**  
and made **intercession for the transgressors.**



## Mark 14:25 AT

---

Amen, I say to you that I will never again drink of the fruit of the vine until that day when I drink it new in the Kingdom of God.



## Isaiah 25:6 NIV

---

On this mountain the LORD Almighty will prepare  
a feast of rich food for all peoples,  
a banquet of aged **wine**—  
the best of meats and the **finest of wines**.



## Amos 9:13 NIV

---

“The days are coming,” declares the LORD,

“when the reaper will be overtaken by the plowman  
and the planter by the one treading grapes.

**New wine** will drip from the mountains  
and flow from all the hills,
