



John 3:1-4 NIV

1 Now there was a Pharisee, a man named Nicodemus who was a member of the Jewish ruling council. 2 He came to Jesus at night and said, "Rabbi, we know that you are a teacher who has come from God. For no one could perform the signs you are doing if God were not with him."

3 Jesus replied, "Very truly I tell you, no one can see the kingdom of God unless they are born again."

4 "How can someone be born when they are old?" Nicodemus asked. "Surely they cannot enter a second time into their mother's womb to be born!"





John 3:5-8 NIV

5 Jesus answered, "Very truly I tell you, no one can enter the kingdom of God unless they are born of water and the Spirit. 6 Flesh gives birth to flesh, but the Spirit gives birth to spirit. 7 You should not be surprised at my saying, 'You must be born again.' 8 The wind blows wherever it pleases. You hear its sound, but you cannot tell where it comes from or where it is going. So it is with everyone born of the Spirit."





John 2:23 NIV

Now while he was in **Jerusalem** at the **Passover Festival**, **many people** saw the **signs** he was performing and believed in his name.





John 2:24-25 ESV

24 But Jesus on his part did not entrust himself to them, because he knew all people 25 and needed no one to bear witness about man, for he himself knew what was in man.





John 3:1 AT

Now there was a man of the Pharisees named Nicodemus, a leader of the Jews.





John 3:2 AT

This man came to Him at night and said to Him, "Rabbi, we know you are a teacher who has come from God. For no one can do these signs that You do unless God is with him."





John 3:18-21 NIV

18 Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe stands condemned already because they have not believed in the name of God's one and only Son. 19 This is the verdict: Light has come into the world, but people loved darkness instead of light because their deeds were evil. 20 Everyone who does evil hates the light, and will not come into the light for fear that their deeds will be exposed. 21 But whoever lives by the truth comes into the light, so that it may be seen plainly that what they have done has been done in the sight of God.





John 13:30 NIV

As soon as Judas had taken the bread, he went out. And it was night.





John 3:3 AT

Jesus answered and said to him, "Amen, Amen, I say to you: unless someone is born again [/from above], they cannot see the kingdom of God."





John 4:34 AT

Jesus says to them, "My food is to do the will of Him who sent me and to finish His work."





John 4:9-10 NIV

9 The Samaritan woman said to him, "You are a Jew and I am a Samaritan woman. How can you ask me for a drink?" (For Jews do not associate with Samaritans.) 10 Jesus answered her, "If you knew the gift of God and who it is that asks you for a drink, you would have asked him and he would have given you living water."





John 4:13-14 NIV

13 Jesus answered, "Everyone who drinks this water will be thirsty again, 14 but whoever drinks the water I give them will never thirst. Indeed, the water I give them will become in them a spring of water welling up to eternal life."





John 7:37-39 NIV

37 On the last and greatest day of the festival, Jesus stood and said in a loud voice, "Let anyone who is thirsty come to me and drink. 38 Whoever believes in me, as Scripture has said, rivers of living water will flow from within them." 39 By this he meant the Spirit, whom those who believed in him were later to receive. Up to that time the Spirit had not been given, since Jesus had not yet been glorified.





1 John 3:9 NIV

No one who is **born** [γεννάω | gennaō] **of God** will continue to sin, because **God's seed** remains in them; they cannot go on sinning, because they have been **born** [γεννάω | gennaō] **of God**.





John 1:10-13 NIV

10 He was in the world, and though the world was made through him, the world did not recognize him. 11 He came to that which was his own, but his own did not receive him. 12 Yet to all who did receive him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become **children of God**— 13 children born not of natural descent, nor of human decision or a husband's will, but born [γεννάω | gennaō] of God.





John 3:28-31 NIV

28 You yourselves can testify that I said, 'I am not the Messiah but am sent ahead of him.' 29 The bride belongs to the bridegroom. The friend who attends the bridegroom waits and listens for him, and is full of joy when he hears the bridegroom's voice. That joy is mine, and it is now complete. 30 He must become greater; I must become less."

31 The one who comes **from above** [ἄνωθεν | *anōthen*)] is above all; the one who is from the earth belongs to the earth, and speaks as one from the earth. The one who comes **from heaven** is above all.





James 1:17 NIV

Every good and perfect gift is **from above** [ἄνωθεν | *anōthen*], coming down from the **Father** of the **heavenly lights**, who does not change like shifting shadows.





John 3:36 NIV

Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life, but whoever rejects the Son will not see life, for God's wrath remains on them.





John 8:51 NIV

Very truly [lit. Amen, Amen] I tell you, whoever **obeys my word** will never **see** death."





John 3:4 AT

Nicodemus says to Him, "How can a man be born when he is an old man? He can't go into his mother's womb a second time and be born, can he?"





John 3:5 AT

Jesus answered, "Amen, Amen, I say to you: unless someone is born of water and [the] Spirit, they cannot enter the kingdom of God."





John 3:9-10 NIV

9 "How can this be?" Nicodemus asked. 10 "You are Israel's **teacher**," said Jesus, "and do **you** not understand these things?





Ezekiel 36:25-27 NIV

25 I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you will be clean; I will cleanse you from all your impurities and from all your idols. 26 I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit in you; I will remove from you your heart of stone and give you a heart of flesh. 27 And I will put my Spirit in you and move you to follow my decrees and be careful to keep my laws. (cf. Joel 2:28; Is 32:15-20, 44:3)





John 3:6 AT

What is born of the flesh is flesh, and what is born of the Spirit is spirit.





John 3:7 AT

You should not be amazed that I said, 'You (all) must be born again [/from above].'





John 3:8 AT

The wind [πνεῦμα | pneuma] blows wherever it wishses. And you hear its sound, but do not know from where it is coming nor where it is going. So it is with everyone who is born of the Spirit [πνεῦμα | pneuma].
