MATTHEW 2:1 JESUS' BIRTHDAY



Then, after Jesus was born in Bethlehem in Judea, in the days of King Herod, behold: Magi from the East arrived in Jerusalem (Mt 2:1, AT)





•1 In the second year of his reign, Nebuchadnezzar had dreams; his mind was troubled and he could not sleep. 2 So the king summoned the magicians, enchanters [LXX: magos] sorcerers and astrologers to tell him what he had dreamed. (Dn 2:1-2, NIV)





• 10 The astrologers answered the king, "There is no one on earth who can do what the king asks! No king, however great and mighty, has ever asked such a thing of any magician or enchanter [LXX: magos] or astrologer. 11 What the king asks is too difficult. No one can reveal it to the king except the gods, and they do not live among humans." (Dn 2:10-11, NIV)





•12 This made the king so angry and furious that he ordered the execution of all the wise men of **Babylon**. 13 So the decree was issued to put the wise men to death, and men were sent to look for Daniel and his friends to put them to death. (Dn 2:12-13, NIV)





• "Do not allow a sorceress to live. (Ex 22:18, NIV) •" 'A man or woman who is a **medium** or **spiritist** among you must be put to death. You are to stone them; their blood will be on their own heads.'" (Lev 20:27, NIV)





• 9 When you enter the land the LORD [YHWH] your God is giving you, do not learn to imitate the detestable ways of the nations there. 10 Let no one be found among you who sacrifices their son or daughter in the fire, who practices divination or sorcery, interprets omens, engages in witchcraft, 11 or casts spells, or who is a medium or spiritist or who consults the dead. 12 Anyone who does these things is detestable to the LORD [YHWH]; because of these same **detestable** practices the LORD [YHWH] your God will drive out those nations before you. 13 You must be blameless before the LORD [YHWH] your God. (Dt 18:9-13, NIV)





•You, LORD [YHWH], have abandoned your people, the descendants of Jacob. They are full of superstitions from the East; they practice divination like the Philistines and embrace pagan customs. (Is 2:6, NIV)





•saying, "Where is the One who was born King of the Jews? For we saw His star at its rising [or in the East] and we have come to worship Him." (Mt 2:2, AT)





•Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the **Father of the heavenly lights**, who does not change like shifting shadows. (Jas 1:17, NIV)





•"I see him, but not now; I behold him, but not near. A star will come out of Jacob; a scepter will rise out of Israel. (Num 24:17a, NIV)





•"I, Jesus, have sent my angel to give you this testimony for the churches. I am the Root and the Offspring of David, and the bright Morning Star." (Rev 22:16, NIV)



MATTHEW 2:3 ALL SHOOK UP



•But when King Herod heard, he was unsettled – and **all** Jerusalem with him. (Mt 2:3, AT)



MATTHEW 2:3 JOURNEY FOR JESUS



•He had begun his journey from **Babylon** on the first day of the first month, and he arrived in Jerusalem on the first day of the fifth month, for the gracious hand of his God was on him. (Ez 7:9, NIV)



MATTHEW 2:4 JESUS JEOPARDY



•And having assembled all the people's chief priests and teachers of the law, he asked them where the Messiah (Χριστός | Christos | Christ) was to be born. (Mt 2:4, AT)



MATTHEW 2:5-6 PROPHECY FULFILLED



•5 Then they said to him, "In Bethlehem of Judah. For so it has been written by the prophet: 6 And you, Bethlehem, [in the] land of Judah | are by no means least among the rulers of Judah | For out of you will come a ruler | Who will shepherd My people, Israel (Mt 2:5-6, AT)



MATTHEW 2:5-6 PROPHECY FULFILLED



• "But you, Bethlehem Ephrathah, though you are small among the clans of Judah, out of you will come for me one who will be ruler over Israel, whose origins are from of old, from ancient times." (Mic 5:2, NIV)



MATTHEW 2:5-6 PROPHECY FULFILLED



Does not Scripture say that the Messiah will come from David's descendants and from Bethlehem, the town where David lived?" (Jn 7:42, NIV)



MATTHEW 2:5-6 SHEPHERD-KING



•In the past, while Saul was king over us, you were the one who led Israel on their military campaigns. And the LORD [YHWH] said to you, 'You will shepherd my people Israel, and you will become their ruler. (2 Sam 5:2, NIV)



MATTHEW 2:5-6 PROPHESIED SHEPHERD-KING



•23 I will place over them one shepherd, my servant David, and he will tend them; he will tend them and be their shepherd. 24 I the LORD [YHWH] will be their God, and my servant David will be prince among them. I the LORD [YHWH] have spoken. (Eze 34:23-24, NIV)



MATTHEW 2:5-6 PROPHESIED SHEPHERD-KING



• 3 Therefore Israel will be abandoned until the time when she who is in labor bears a son, and the rest of his brothers return to join the Israelites. 4 He will stand and shepherd his flock in the strength of the LORD [YHWH], in the majesty of the name of the LORD [YHWH] his God. And they will live securely, for then his greatness will reach to the ends of the earth. 5 And he will be our peace when the Assyrians invade our land and march through our fortresses. We will raise against them seven shepherds, even eight commanders, (Mic 5:3-5, NIV)



MATTHEW 2:7-8 UNDERCOVER MEETING, UNDERCOVER MOTIVE



•7 Then Herod, having secretly called the Magi, ascertained from them the precise time of the shining star. 8 And sending them into Bethlehem, he said, "Go, investigate precisely about the Child. Then, when you find [Him], report back to me, so that I too may come and worship Him. (Mt 2:7-8, AT)





•Then they, having heard the King, went and behold: the star which they had seen at its rising [or in the East]! It went before them until it came to a standstill over [the place] where the Child was. (Mt 2:9, AT)





• The mystery of the seven **stars** that you saw in my right hand and of the seven golden lampstands is this: The seven **stars** are the **angels** of the seven churches, and the seven lampstands are the seven churches. (Rev 1:20, NIV)





• Then the angel of God, who had been traveling in front of Israel's army, withdrew and went behind them. The pillar of cloud also moved from in front and stood behind them, (Ex 14:19, NIV; cf. Ex 23:20)





•By day the LORD [YHWH] went ahead of them in a pillar of cloud to guide them on their way and by night in a pillar of fire to give them light, so that they could travel by day or night. (Ex 13:21, NIV)





•When they saw the star, they were overjoyed with exceedingly great joy. (Mt 2:10, AT)





• 39 Zadok the priest took the horn of oil from the sacred tent and anointed Solomon. Then they sounded the trumpet and all the people shouted, "Long live King Solomon!" 40 And all the people went up after him, playing pipes and rejoicing greatly, so that the ground shook with the sound. (1 Ki 1:39-40, NIV)





•"The kingdom of heaven is like treasure hidden in a field. When a man found it, he hid it again, and then in his joy $\left[\chi \alpha \rho \dot{\alpha} \right]$ chara] went and sold all he had and bought that field. (Mt 13:44, NIV)





• "His master replied, 'Well done, good and faithful servant! You have been faithful with a few things; I will put you in charge of many things. Come and share your master's happiness! [χαρά | *chara*]' (Mt 25:21, NIV)





•And when they came into the house, they saw the Child with His mother Mary and, falling down [to their knees], they worshipped Him. And having opened their treasure chests, they presented Him with gifts – gold, frankincense, and myrrh. (Mt 2:11, AT)





•Who is this coming up from the wilderness like a column of smoke, perfumed with myrrh and incense made from all the spices of the merchant? (Songs 3:6, NIV)





• 34 Then the LORD [YHWH] said to Moses, "Take fragrant spices—gum resin, onycha and galbanum—and **pure frankincense**, all in equal amounts, 35 and make a fragrant blend of incense, the work of a perfumer. It is to be salted and pure and sacred. 36 Grind some of it to powder and place it in front of the ark of the covenant law in the tent of meeting, where I will meet with you. It shall be most holy to you. 37 Do not make any incense with this formula for yourselves; consider it holy to the LORD. 38 Whoever makes incense like it to enjoy its fragrance must be cut off from their people." (Ex 30:34-38, NIV)





•Then they offered him wine mixed with **myrrh**, but he did not take it. (Mk 15:23, NIV)





• 39 He [Joseph of Arimathea] was accompanied by Nicodemus, the man who earlier had visited Jesus at night. Nicodemus brought a mixture of myrrh and aloes, about seventy-five pounds. 40 Taking Jesus' body, the two of them wrapped it, with the spices, in strips of linen. This was in accordance with Jewish burial customs. (Jn 19:39-40, NIV)





•Herds of camels will cover your land, young camels of Midian and Ephah. And all from Sheba will come, bearing gold and incense and proclaiming the praise of the LORD [YHWH]. (Is 60:6, NIV)





•Surely the islands look to me; in the lead are the ships of Tarshish, bringing your children from afar, with their silver and gold, to the honor of the LORD [YHWH] your God, the Holy One of Israel, for he has endowed you with splendor. (Is 60:9, NIV)





•And she gave the king 120 talents of gold, large quantities of spices, and precious stones. Never again were so many spices brought in as those the queen of Sheba gave to King Solomon. (1 Ki 10:10, NIV)





•10 May the kings of Tarshish and of distant shores bring tribute to him. May the kings of Sheba and Seba present him gifts. 11 May all kings bow down to him and all nations serve him. (Ps 72:10-11, NIV; also see Ps 45:7-9)





• 7 You love righteousness and hate wickedness; therefore God, your God, has set you above your companions by anointing you with the oil of joy. 8 All your robes are fragrant with myrrh and aloes and cassia; from palaces adorned with ivory the music of the strings makes you glad. 9 Daughters of kings are among your honored women; at your right hand is the royal bride in gold of Ophir. (Ps 45:7-9, NIV)







 And having received a divine warning in a dream not to return to Herod, they withdrew to their land by different way. (Mt 2:12, AT)
