



John 9:25 NIV

He replied, “Whether he is a sinner or not, I don’t know. One thing I do know. I was blind but now I see!”



John 9:11 NIV

He replied, “**The man they call Jesus made some mud and put it on my eyes. He told me to go to Siloam and wash. So I went and washed, and then I could see.**”



John 9:13-14 AT

13 They bring to the Pharisees that man who was once blind. 14 Now the day on which Jesus made the mud and opened the man's eyes was a **Sabbath**.



Exodus 20:8-10 AT

8 Remember the Sabbath Day, to keep it holy. 9 Six days you shall labor and do all your work, 10 But the seventh day is a Sabbath to the LORD [YHWH] your God. [**On it,**] **you shall not do any work** – neither you, nor your son or daughter, nor your male or female slave, nor your animals, nor any foreigner within your gates.



John 9:15-16 AT

15 So the Pharisees were also again asking him how he gained his sight. And he said to them, "He put mud on my eyes, and I washed, and I see."

16 Then some of the Pharisees were saying, "This man is not from God because He does not keep the Sabbath." But others were saying, "How can a sinful man perform such **signs**?" And there was **division** among them.



Lk 12:51-53 AT

51 You think *peace* I have come to establish **on the earth**? No, I tell you, but rather **division**. 52 For, from now on, it will be five divided in one house: three against two and two against three.

53 Father will be **divided** against son
and son against father,
mother against daughter
and daughter against mother,
mother-in-law against her daughter-in-law
and daughter-in-law against mother-in-law.” [Mic 7:6]

John 9:17-19 AT

17 So they again say to the [formerly] blind man, "What do you say about Him, since He opened your eyes?"

Then he said to them, "He is a prophet."

18 But the Jews did not believe [this] about him – that he was blind and then gained his sight – until they called for the parents of the man who gained his sight 19 and questioned them saying, "Is this your son, who you say was born blind? How then does he now see?"



John 9:20-23 AT

20 Then his parents answered and said, "We know that this is our son and that he was born blind. 21 But we don't know how he now sees, nor do we know who opened his eyes. Ask him. He is of age; he will speak for himself." 22

His parents said these things because they were afraid of the Jews. For the Jews had already agreed with each other that if anyone acknowledged Him as the Messiah [Christ], they would be excommunicated from the synagogue. 23

This is why his parents said, "He is of age; ask him."



John 9:24-25 AT

24 So they called for the man a second time – the man who was [once] blind – and said to him, "Give glory to God! We know that this guy is a sinner." 25 Then he answered these men: "Whether he is a sinner or not, I don't know. One thing I do know: Though I was **blind**, now I **see**."



Joshua 7:19 NIV

Then Joshua said to Achan, “My son, **give glory to the LORD [YHWH]**, the God of Israel, and **honor him. Tell me what you have done; do not hide it from me.**”



John 9:26-29 AT

26 Then they said to him, "What did He do to you? How did He open your eyes?" 27 He answered them, "I told you already and you did not listen. Why do you want to hear it again? You don't also want to become disciples of His, do you?"

28 Then they hurled insults at him and said, "You are a disciple of that [man], but we are disciples of Moses. 29 We know that God has spoken to Moses, but we don't know where this [guy] is from.



John 9:30-33 AT

30 The man answered and said to them, "Well, this is **amazing**: you don't know where He is from, and yet He opened my eyes. 31 We know that God does not listen to sinners. But if anyone is godly and does the will [of God], He listens. 32 From the beginning of time, it has never been heard that someone opened the eyes of a person born blind. 33 If this man were not from God, He would not be able to do anything."



Prayers of the Righteous...

The LORD [YHWH] **detests** the **sacrifice** of the **wicked**,

John 3:2 AT

This man came to Him **at night** and said to Him, "Rabbi, we know you are a teacher who has **come from God**. For **no one can do these signs that You do unless God is with him.**"



John 9:34 AT

They answered and said to him,
"You were born wholly in sin,
and you are teaching us?" And
they threw him out.



John 9:1-3 NIV

1 As he went along, he saw a man blind from birth. 2 His disciples asked him, “Rabbi, **who sinned, this man or his parents, that he was born blind?**”

3 “**Neither** this man nor his parents sinned,” said Jesus, “but this happened so that the works of God might be displayed in him.”



John 9:35 AT

Jesus heard that they threw him out and, when He found him, He said, "Do you believe in the Son of Man?"



Daniel 7:13-14 NIV

13 “In my vision at night I looked, and there before me was one like a **son of man**, coming with the clouds of heaven. He approached the Ancient of Days and was led into his presence. 14 He was given authority, glory and sovereign power; **all nations** and peoples of **every language worshiped him**. His dominion is an **everlasting dominion** that will not pass away, and his **kingdom** is one that will **never be destroyed**.



John 9:36-38 AT

36 That man answered and said, "And who is He, **Lord**? [Tell me] so that I may **believe in Him**."

37 Jesus said to Him, "Indeed you have **seen Him**, and the One speaking with you is He."

38 Then he declared, "**Lord**, I believe!!" And he worshipped Him.



John 9:39 AT

Then, Jesus said, "For judgment [κρίμα | *krima*] I have come into this world, so that those who **don't see may see**, and those who **do see may become blind.**"



John 3:16 AT

For, in this way, God loved the world: that He gave the one-of-a-kind Son, so that everyone who is [continually] faithful to Him shall not perish but have eternal life.



John 3:17 AT

For God did **not** send the Son into the world in order to **condemn** [κρίνω | *krinō*] the world, but so that the world shall be **saved** through Him.



John 5:22-23 NIV

22 Moreover, the Father **judges** [κρίνω | *krinō*] no one, but has entrusted all **judgment** [κρίσις | *krisis*] to the Son, 23 that all may honor the Son just as they honor the Father. Whoever does not honor the Son does not honor the Father, who sent him.



John 12:47-48 NIV

47 “If anyone hears my words but does not keep them, I do not **judge** [κρίνω | *krinō*] that person.

For I did not come to **judge** [κρίνω | *krinō*] the world, but to **save** the world. 48 There is a **judge** [κρίνω | *krinō*] for the one who rejects me and does not accept my words; **the very words I have spoken will condemn** [κρίνω | *krinō*] **them** at the last day.



John 3:18-21 NIV

18 Whoever **believes in** him is not **condemned** [κρίνω | *krinō*], but whoever does not believe stands **condemned** [κρίνω | *krinō*] already because they have not **believed in** the name of God's one and only Son. 19 This is the verdict [κρίσις | *krisis*]: **Light has come into the world**, but people loved **darkness instead of light** because **their deeds were evil**. 20 Everyone who **does evil hates the light**, and **will not come into the light** for fear that their deeds will be exposed. 21 But whoever **lives by the truth comes into the light**, so that it may be seen plainly that what they have done has been done in the sight of God.



Isaiah 42:18-20 NIV

- 18 “Hear, you deaf;
look, **you blind**, and **see!**
- 19 Who is **blind** but **my servant**,
and deaf like the messenger I send?
Who is **blind** like the one in covenant with me,
blind like the servant of the LORD [YHWH]?
- 20 You have **seen** many things, but you **pay no attention**;
your ears are open, but you **do not listen.**”



Isaiah 6:8 NIV

Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, “Whom shall I send? And who will go for us?”

And I said, “Here am I. Send me!”



Isaiah 6:9-10 NIV

9 He said, “Go and tell this people:

“ ‘Be ever hearing, but never understanding;
be ever **seeing**, but never **perceiving**.’

10 Make the heart of this people calloused;
make their ears dull
and **close their eyes**.

Otherwise they might **see with their eyes**,
hear with their ears,
understand with their hearts,
and turn and be healed.”



Isaiah 29:18 NIV

In that day the deaf will hear the words of the scroll,
and out of **gloom** and **darkness**
the **eyes** of the **blind** will see.



Isaiah 35:5-6ab NIV

- 5 Then will the **eyes** of the **blind** be **opened**
and the ears of the deaf unstopped.
- 6 Then will the lame leap like a deer,
and the mute tongue shout for joy.



Isaiah 42:6-7 NIV

- 6 “I, the LORD [YHWH], have called you in righteousness;
I will take hold of your hand.
I will keep you and will make you
to be a **covenant** for the people
and a **light** for the Gentiles,
- 7 to **open eyes** that are **blind**,
to free captives from prison
and to release from the dungeon those who sit in **darkness**.



John 9:40-41 AT

40 Some of the Pharisees who were with Him heard these things. And they said to Him, "We aren't **blind**, too, are we?"

41 Jesus said to them, "If you were **blind**, you would not have sin. But now that you say, 'We **see**', your sin remains."
