CONTEXT PSALM 23



The LORD [YHWH] is my shepherd; I do not lack (Ps 23:1, AT)

In pastures of new green grass, He lets me lie down; by waters of complete rest, He guides me (Ps 23:2, AT)

PSALM 23:4 HOSTILE CIRCUMSTANCES



Even though I walk through the darkest valley

I fear no evil because You are with me

Your rod and Your staff comfort me

Have the gates of death been shown to you?

Have you seen the gates of the **deepest darkness** [צַלְמָוֶת | ṣalmāwet]? (Job 38:17, NIV)





The people walking in darkness

have seen a great light;

on those living in the land of **deep darkness** [צַלְמָנֶת | ṣalmāwet] a light has dawned (Is 9:2, NIV)





They did not ask, 'Where is the LORD [YHWH], who brought us up out of Egypt

- and led us through the barren wilderness,
 - through a land of deserts and ravines,
- a land of drought and **utter darkness** [צַלְמָוֶת | ṣalmāwet],
 - a land where no one travels and no one lives?' (Jer 2:6, NIV)





•I am with you and will watch over you wherever you go, and I will bring you back to this land. I will not leave you until I have done what I have promised you." (Gen 28:15, NIV)





- 6 "Alas, Sovereign LORD [YHWH]," I said, "I do not know how to speak; I am too young."
- 7 But the LORD [YHWH] said to me, "Do not say, 'I am too young.' You must go to everyone I send you to and say whatever I command you. 8 Do **not be afraid** of them, for I **am with you** and will **rescue** you," declares the LORD [YHWH]. (Jer 1:6-8, NIV)





•9 Then the LORD [YHWH] reached out his hand and touched my mouth and said to me, "I have put my words in your mouth. 10 See, today I appoint you over nations and kingdoms to uproot and tear down, to destroy and overthrow, to build and to plant." (Jer 1:9-10, NIV)





• 18 Today I have made you a fortified city, an iron pillar and a bronze wall to stand against the whole land—against the kings of Judah, its officials, its priests and the people of the land. 19 They will fight against you but will not overcome you, for I am with you and will rescue you," declares the LORD [YHWH]. (Jer 1:18-19, NIV)





So do not fear, for I am with you;

do not be dismayed, for I am your God.

I will strengthen you and help you;

I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.

(Is 41:10, NIV)





- 11 "All who rage against you will surely be ashamed and disgraced; those who oppose you will be as **nothing** and perish.
- will be as **nothing** and perish.

 12 Though you search for your enemies, you will not find them.

 Those who wage war against you will be as **nothing** at all.
- 13 For I am the LORD [YHWH] your God who takes hold of your right hand and says to you, Do not fear; I will help you. (Is 41:11-13, NIV)



PSALM 23:4 THE RIGHTEOUS SHEPHERD'S ROD AND STAFF




Shepherd your people with your staff [שֶׁבֶּט | šēbeṭ],

the flock of your inheritance,

- which lives by itself in a forest,
 - in fertile pasturelands.
- Let them feed in Bashan and Gilead as in days long ago.
- "As in the days when you came out of Egypt,
 - I will show them my wonders." (Mic 7:14-15, NIV)







You prepare before me a table

in front of my enemies

You anoint with oil my head

my cup overflows (Ps 23:5, AT)



PSALM 23:5 THE LORD IS MY HOST



18 They willfully put God to the test

by demanding the food they craved.

19 They spoke against God; they said,

"Can God really spread a table in the wilderness? (Ps 78:19, NIV)





• 13 Along with their fellowship offering of thanksgiving they are to present an offering with thick loaves of bread made with yeast. 14 They are to bring one of each kind as an offering, a contribution to the LORD [YHWH]; it belongs to the priest who splashes the blood of the fellowship offering against the altar. 15 The meat of their fellowship offering of thanksgiving must be eaten on the day it is offered; they must leave none of it till morning. (Lev 7:13-15, NIV)





• 16 "'If, however, their offering is the result of a vow or is a freewill offering, the sacrifice shall be eaten on the day they offer it, but anything left over may be eaten on the next day. 17 Any meat of the sacrifice left over till the third day must be burned up. (Lev 7:16-17, NIV)





• 4 You must not worship the LORD [YHWH] your God in their way. 5 But you are to seek the place the LORD [YHWH] your God will choose from among all your tribes to put his Name there for his dwelling [שַׁבּן šākan]. To that place you must go; 6 there bring your burnt offerings and sacrifices, your tithes and special gifts, what you have vowed to give and your freewill offerings, and the firstborn of your herds and flocks. 7 There, in the presence of the LORD [YHWH] your God, you and your families shall eat and shall rejoice in everything you have put your hand to, because the LORD [YHWH] your God has blessed you. (Dt 12:4-7, NIV)





• 8 You are not to do as we do here today, everyone doing as they see fit, 9 since you have not yet reached the **resting place** [מְנוּחָה | měnûḥâ)] and the inheritance the LORD [YHWH] your God is giving you. 10 But you will cross the Jordan and settle in the land the LORD [YHWH] your God is giving you as an inheritance, and he will give you **rest**

[רוֹם $|\hat{n}\hat{u}ah$] from all your enemies around you so that you will live in safety. 11 Then to the place the LORD [YHWH] your God will choose as a **dwelling** [$|\hat{s}akan$] for his Name—there you are to bring everything I command you: your **burnt offerings** and **sacrifices**, your tithes and special gifts, and all the choice possessions you have vowed to the LORD [YHWH]. (Dt 12:8-11, NIV)





• 12 And there rejoice before the LORD [YHWH] your God—you, your sons and daughters, your male and female servants, and the Levites from your towns who have no allotment or inheritance of their own. 13 Be careful not to sacrifice your burnt offerings anywhere you please. 14 Offer them only at the place the LORD [YHWH] will choose in one of your tribes, and there observe everything I command you. (Dt 12:12-14, NIV)





- 7 Then he took the Book of the **Covenant** and read it to the people. They responded, "**We will do** everything the LORD [YHWH] has said; we will obey."
- 8 Moses then took the **blood**, **sprinkled it on the people** and said, "This is the **blood of the covenant** that the LORD [YHWH] has made with you in accordance with all these words." (Ex 24:7-8, NIV)





• 9 Moses and Aaron, Nadab and Abihu, and the seventy elders of Israel went up 10 and saw the God of Israel. Under his feet was something like a pavement made of lapis lazuli [sapphire], as bright blue as the sky. 11 But God did not raise his hand against these leaders of the Israelites; they saw God, and they ate and drank. (Ex 24:9-12, NIV)





• 23 For I received from the Lord what I also passed on to you: The Lord Jesus, on the night he was betrayed, took bread, 24 and when he had given thanks, he broke it and said, "This is my body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of me." 25 In the same way, after supper he took the cup, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood; do this, whenever you drink it, in remembrance of me." (1 Cor 11:23-25, NIV)



PSALM 23:5 ANOINTED WITH OIL



•You did not **put oil on my head**, but she has poured perfume on my feet. (Lk 7:46, NIV)



PSALM 23:6 PURSUIT OF FAITHFULNESS



Surely, goodness and loyal love will pursue me all the days of my life

and I will return to [or dwell in] the house of the LORD [YHWH] for the length of my days (Ps 23:6, AT)



PSALM 23:6 PURSUIT OF THE FAITHLESS



My times are in your hands;

deliver me from the hands of my enemies,

from those who pursue [קדַס | rādap] me.

(Ps 31:15, NIV)



PSALM 23:6 PURSUIT OF THE FAITHLESS



- 1 Contend, LORD [YHWH], with those who contend with me; fight against those who fight against me.
- 2 Take up shield and armor; arise and come to my aid.
- 3 Brandish spear and javelin against those who **pursue** [קָדַף | rādap] me.

Say to me,

"I am your salvation." (Ps 35:1-3, NIV)



PSALM 23:6 PURSUIT OF THE FAITHLESS



LORD [YHWH] my God, I take refuge in you;

save and deliver me from all who **pursue** [$777 \mid r\bar{a}dap$] me,

or they will tear me apart like a lion

and rip me to pieces with no one to rescue me. (Ps 7:1, NIV)



PSALM 23:6 THE HOUSE OF THE LORD




I was glad when they said unto me,

Let us go into the house of the LORD [YHWH]. (Ps 122:1, KJV)

Our feet are standing in your gates, Jerusalem. (Ps 122:2, NIV)







One thing I ask from the LORD [YHWH], this only do I seek:

that I may dwell [יָשַׁב $y\bar{a}\check{s}ab$] in the house of the LORD [YHWH] all the days of my life,

to gaze on the beauty of the LORD [YHWH] and to seek him in his temple. (Ps 27:4, NIV)



PSALM 23:6 THE HOUSE OF THE LORD



- 3 Know that the LORD is God.
 - It is he who made us, and we are his;
 - we are his people, the sheep of his pasture.
- 4 Enter his gates with thanksgiving
 - and his courts with praise;
 - give thanks to him and praise his name. (Ps 100:3-4, NIV)



PSALM 23:6 FOR THE REST OF MY DAYS



Your statutes, LORD [YHWH], stand firm;

holiness adorns your house

for endless days [לְאָרֶר יָמְים]. (Ps 93:5, NIV)



PSALM 23 THE SECOND EXODUS



• Two men, Moses and Elijah, appeared in glorious splendor, talking with Jesus. They spoke about his departure [ἔξοδος | exhodos], which he was about to bring to fulfillment at Jerusalem. (Lk 9:30-31, NIV)





•I am the Shepherd – the Good One. The Shepherd – the Good One – lays down His life for the sheep. (Jn 10:11, AT)





•24 "He himself bore our sins" in his body on the cross, so that we might die to sins and live for righteousness; "by his wounds you have been healed." 25 For "you were like sheep going astray," but now you have returned to the Shepherd and Overseer of your souls. (1 Pet 2:24-25, NIV)





•And when the **Chief Shepherd** appears, you will receive the crown of glory that will never fade away. (1 Pet 5:4, NIV)





•For the Lamb at the center of the throne will be their shepherd; 'he will lead them to springs of living water.' 'And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes.'" (Rev 7:17, NIV)



PSALM 23 THE TEMPLE OF GOD



•Don't you know that you yourselves are God's temple and that God's Spirit dwells in your midst? (1 Cor 3:16, NIV)



PSALM 23 THE TEMPLE OF GOD



• 18 Flee from sexual immorality. All other sins a person commits are outside the body, but whoever sins sexually, sins against their own body. 19 Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own; 20 you were bought at a price. Therefore honor God with your bodies. (1 Cor 6:18-20, NIV)



PSALM 23 GOD WITH US!



• 19 Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age." (Mt 28:19-20, NIV; cf. Mt 1:23, 18:20)



PSALM 23 THE GREAT SHEPHERD



• 20 Now may the God of peace, who through the blood of the eternal covenant brought back from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great Shepherd of the sheep, 21 equip you with everything good for doing his will, and may he work in us what is pleasing to him, through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen. (Heb 13:20-21, NIV)
