The Fifth Commandment: A Pivotal Principle

37 Jesus replied: "'Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' [Dt 6:5] 38 This is the first and greatest commandment. 39 And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' [Lev 19:18] 40 All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments." (Mt 22:37-40, NIV)





The Fifth Commandment: A Weighty Word

Honor [$| k\bar{a}b\bar{e}d$] your father and your mother so that your days will be lengthened in the land that the LORD [YHWH] your God is giving to you. (Ex 20:12, AT I)

Give **weight** [בְּבֵּל $k\bar{a}b\bar{e}d$] to your father and your mother so that your days will be lengthened in the land that the LORD [YHWH] your God is giving to you. (Ex 20:12, AT II)





Honor Your Father *And* Mother

Listen, my son, to the discipline of your father,

and do not forsake the instruction of your mother. (Pr 1:8, AT)





Honor Your Father And Mother

"Each of you must respect your mother and father, and you must observe my Sabbaths. I am the LORD [YHWH] your God. (Lev 19:3, NIV)





Grave Consequences

- "Anyone who attacks their father or mother is to be put to death. (Ex 21:15, NIV)
- "Anyone who curses their father or mother is to be put to death. (Ex 21:17, NIV)
- "'Anyone who curses their father or mother is to be put to death. Because they have cursed their father or mother, their blood will be on their own head. (Lev 20:9, NIV)






Grave Consequences

Honor Your Father And Mother: Care For Elderly Parents



9 And he continued, "You have a fine way of setting aside the commands of God in order to observe your own traditions! 10 For Moses said, 'Honor your father and mother,' [Ex 20:12; Dt 5:16] and, 'Anyone who curses their father or mother is to be put to death.' [Ex 21:17, Lev 20:9] 11 But you say that if anyone declares that what might have been used to help their father or mother is Corban (that is, devoted to God)—12 then you no longer let them do anything for their father or mother. 13 Thus you nullify the word of God by your tradition that you have handed down. And you do many things like that." (Mk 7:9-13, NIV)







- 15 "Cursed is anyone who makes an idol—a thing detestable to the LORD [YHWH], the work of skilled hands—and sets it up in secret." Then all the people shall say, "Amen!"
- 16 "Cursed is anyone who dishonors their father or mother." Then all the people shall say, "Amen!"

(Dt 27:15-16, NIV)





Follow the LORD's Law To Live In the LORD's Land

15 See, I set before you today life and prosperity, death and destruction. 16 For I command you today to love the LORD [YHWH] your God, to walk in obedience to him, and to keep his commands, decrees and laws; then you will live and increase, and the LORD [YHWH] your God will bless you in the land you are entering to possess. (Dt 30:15-16, NIV)





Follow the LORD's Law To Live In the LORD's Land

17 But if your heart turns away and you are not obedient, and if you are drawn away to bow down to other gods and worship them, 18 I declare to you this day that you will certainly be destroyed. You will not live long in the land you are crossing the Jordan to enter and possess. (Dt 30:17-18, NIV)





God's People, God's Property

3 Then Moses went up to God, and the LORD [YHWH] called to him from the mountain and said, "This is what you are to say to the descendants of Jacob and what you are to tell the people of Israel: 4 'You yourselves have seen what I did to Egypt, and how I carried you on eagles' wings and brought you to myself. 5 Now if you obey me fully and keep my covenant, then out of all nations you will be my treasured possession. Although the whole earth is mine, 6 you will be for me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.' These are the words you are to speak to the Israelites." (Ex 19:3-6, NIV)





God's People, God's Property

9 But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light. 10 Once you were not a people, but now you are the people of God; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy. (1 Pet 2:9-10, NIV)



Honoring One's Father And Mother: New Testament



1 Children obey your parents in the Lord. For this is right. 2 "Honor your father and mother" – which is the first commandment with a promise – 3 "So that it may go well for you and that you will live long in the land." (Eph 6:1-3, AT)

(cf. Mt 15:4, 19:19; Mk 7:10; 10:19; Lk 18:20; Col 3:20-21)





Spiritual Training

And, fathers, do not provoke your children to anger, but bring them up in the training and instruction of the Lord. (Eph 6:4, AT)





Spiritual Training
