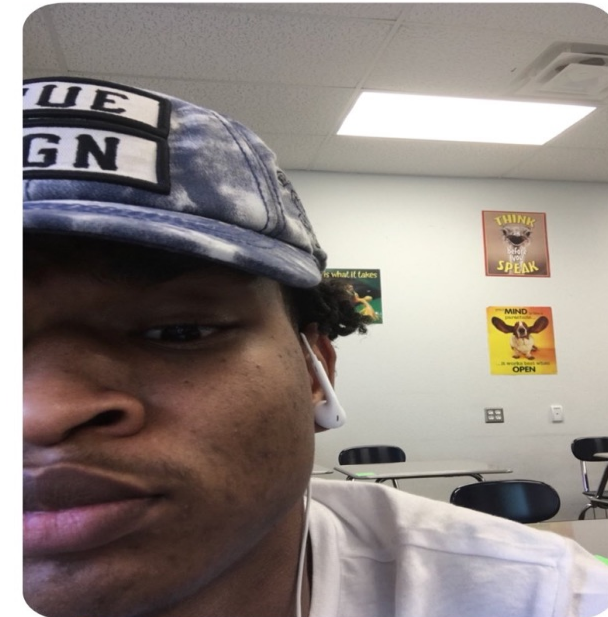

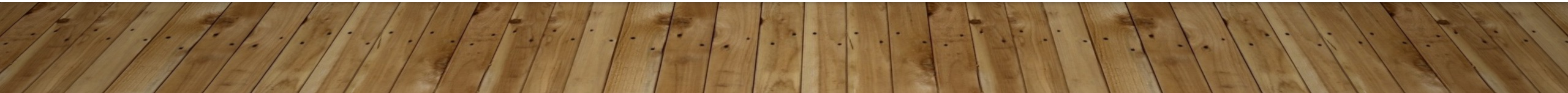

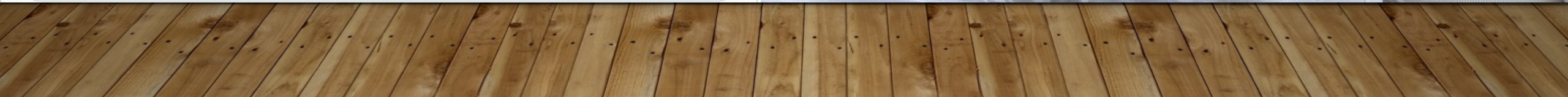

Then, it came to pass: [Jesus] was on the way to Jerusalem and He was passing between Galilee and Samaria.  
(Lk 17:11, AT)

TO JERUSALEM



As the time approached for him to be taken up to heaven, Jesus **resolutely set out for Jerusalem.** (Lk 9:51, NIV)







LUKE 17:12  
SOCIAL DISTANCING:

Then, as He [was] going into a village, ten lepers, who stood at a distance, met Him. (Lk 17:12, AT)





LUKE 17:12  
LEPROSY?  
DIVINE PUNISHMENT



8 With him I speak face to face, clearly and not in riddles; he sees the form of the LORD [YHWH]. Why then were you not afraid to speak against my servant Moses?” 9 The anger of the LORD [YHWH] burned against them, and he left them. 10 When the cloud lifted from above the tent, Miriam’s skin was **leprous**—it became as **white as snow**. Aaron turned toward her and saw that she had a **defiling skin disease**, 11 and he said to Moses, “Please, my lord, I ask you not to hold against us the **sin** we have so foolishly committed. (Num 12:8-11, NIV)





LUKE 17:12  
SOCIAL DISTANCING:  
THE LIFE OF LEPERS



1 The LORD [YHWH] said to Moses, 2 “Command the Israelites to send away from the camp **anyone who has a defiling skin disease** or a discharge of any kind, or who is **ceremonially unclean because of a dead body**. 3 Send away male and female alike; send them **outside the camp** so they will not defile their camp, where I dwell among them. (Num 5:1-3, NIV)





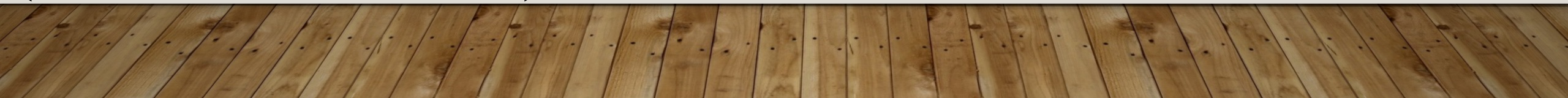


LUKE 17:12  
SOCIAL DISTANCING:  
THE LIFE OF LEPERS



45 “Anyone with such a defiling disease must wear torn clothes, let their hair be unkempt, **cover the lower part of their face** and cry out, ‘**Unclean! Unclean!**’ 46 **As long as they have the disease they remain unclean. They must live alone; they must live outside the camp.**

(Lev 13:45-46, NIV)

“Whoever touches a **human corpse** will be **unclean** for seven days. (Num 19:11, NIV)

SUBMISSION  
PRECEDES SUPPLICATION



**“Father, if you are willing, take this cup from me; yet not my will, but yours be done.” (Lk 22:42, NIV)**

WALK BY  
FAITH



And, when He saw [them], He said to them, "Go, show yourselves to the priests."  
And it came to pass: as they were going, they were cleansed. (Lk 17:14, AT)



LUKE 17:14  
WALK BY  
FAITH



13 Jesus reached out his hand and **touched** the man. “I am **willing**,” he said. “Be clean!” And **immediately the leprosy left him**. 14 Then Jesus ordered him, “Don’t tell anyone, but go, **show yourself to the priest** and offer the sacrifices that Moses commanded for your cleansing, as a testimony to them.” (Lk 5:13-14, NIV)





LUKE 17:15  
TO GOD BE  
THE GLORY!



Then, one of them, when he saw that he was healed, came back – glorifying God with a loud voice. (Lk 17:15, AT)





LUKE 17:16  
APPRECIATIVE  
OUTSIDER



And he fell facedown at the feet of  
Jesus, thanking Him. And he was a  
Samaritan. (Lk 17:16, AT)







LUKE 17:16  
FALL  
ON YOUR KNEES



While Jesus was in one of the towns, a man came along who was covered with **leprosy**. When he saw Jesus, he **fell with his face to the ground** and **begged** him, “Lord, if you are willing, you can make me clean.” (Lk 5:12, NIV)



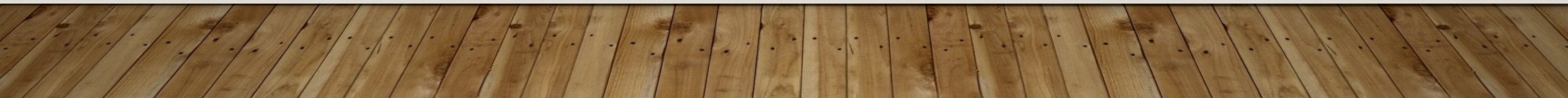


LUKE 17:16

41 Then a man named Jairus, a synagogue leader, came and **fell at Jesus' feet, pleading** with him to come to his house 42 because his **only daughter**, a girl of about twelve, **was dying**.

(Lk 8:41-42a, NIV)







LUKE 17:17-18  
RHETORICAL  
REBUKE



17 Then Jesus replied and said, "Were not ten cleansed? Then, *where* are the [other] nine? 18 None were found coming back to give glory to God except this foreigner?" (Lk 17:17-18, AT)





LUKE 17:19  
SAVING  
FAITH



And He said to him, "Arise! Go!  
Your faith has saved [σώζω | *sōzō*]  
you." (Lk 17:19, AT)

Then he said to her, “Daughter,  
your faith has **healed** [σώζω | *sōzō*]  
you. Go in peace.” (Lk 8:48, NIV)



LUKE 17:19  
HEALINGS:  
SIGNS OF SALVATION



So he replied to the messengers, “Go back and report to John what you have seen and heard: The blind receive sight, the lame walk, **those who have leprosy are cleansed**, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the good news is proclaimed to the poor. (Lk 7:22, NIV)







LUKE 17:19  
SAVING  
FAITH



36 When one of the Pharisees invited Jesus to have dinner with him, he went to the Pharisee's house and reclined at the table. 37 A woman in that town who lived a **sinful life** learned that Jesus was eating at the Pharisee's house, so she came there with an **alabaster jar of perfume**. 38 As she stood behind him **at his feet weeping**, she began to **wet his feet** with her tears. Then she **wiped them with her hair, kissed them and poured perfume on them.** (Lk 7:36-38, NIV)





LUKE 17:19  
SAVING  
FAITH



48 Then Jesus said to her, “Your **sins are forgiven.**”

49 The other guests began to say among themselves,  
“Who is this who even forgives sins?”

50 Jesus said to the woman, “Your faith has **saved** [σώζω | *sōzō*] you; go in peace.” (Lk 7:48-50, NIV)





## PARALLEL PASSAGES



She said to her mistress, “If only my master would see the **prophet** who is in **Samaria!** He would **cure** him of his **leprosy.**” (2 Ki 5:3, NIV)



## PARALLEL PASSAGES



The letter that he took to the king of Israel read: “With this letter I am sending my servant Naaman to you so that you may **cure him of his leprosy.**” (2 Ki 5:6, NIV)





## PARALLEL PASSAGES



As soon as the king of Israel read the letter, he tore his robes and said, “**Am I God? Can I kill and bring back to life? Why does this fellow send someone to me to be cured of his leprosy? See how he is trying to pick a quarrel with me!**” (2 Ki 5:7, NIV)



## PARALLEL PASSAGES



Then Naaman and all his attendants went back to the man of God. He stood before him and said, “**Now I know that there is no God in all the world except in Israel. So please accept a gift from your servant.**” (2 Ki 5:15, NIV)





PARALLEL  
PASSAGES



And there were **many** in **Israel** with **leprosy** in the time of Elisha the prophet, yet not one of them was cleansed—**only Naaman the Syrian.**” (Lk 4:27, NIV)



## HOLY THANKSGIVING: AN OPEN INVITATION



7 Understand, then, that **those who have faith are children of Abraham.** 8 Scripture foresaw that God would **justify the Gentiles by faith**, and announced the **gospel** in advance to Abraham: “All nations will be blessed through you.” [Gen 12:2-3] (Gal 3:7-8, NIV)
