## CONTEXT THE BODY IS A TEMPLE



5 He did away with the idolatrous priests appointed by the kings of Judah to burn incense on the high places of the towns of Judah and on those around Jerusalem those who burned incense to Baal, to the sun and moon, to the constellations and to all the starry hosts. 6 He took the Asherah pole from the temple of the LORD [YHWH] to the Kidron Valley outside Jerusalem and burned it there. He ground it to powder and scattered the dust over the graves of the common people. 7 He also tore down the quarters of the male shrine prostitutes that were in the temple of the LORD [YHWH], the quarters where women did weaving for Asherah. (2 Ki 23:5-7, NIV; cf. Amos 2:7-8)



## CONTEXT THE BODY IS A TEMPLE



1 It is actually reported that there is sexual immorality among you, and of a kind that even pagans do not tolerate: A man is sleeping with his father's wife. 2 And you are proud! Shouldn't you rather have gone into mourning and have put out of your fellowship the man who has been doing this? (1 Cor 5:1-2, NIV; cf. 1 Cor 5:9-13; 6:9-11)







27 "You have heard that it was said, 'You shall not commit adultery.' 28 But I tell you that anyone who looks at a woman lustfully has already committed adultery with her in his heart. (Mt 5:27-28, NIV)



## CONTEXT THE BODY IS A TEMPLE



16 Do you not know that he who unites himself with a prostitute is one with her in body? For it is said, "The two will become one flesh [Gen 2:24]." 17 But whoever is united with the Lord is one with him in spirit. (1 Cor 6:16-17, NIV)



## CONTEXT THE BODY IS A TEMPLE



18 Flee from sexual immorality. All other sins a person commits are outside the body, but whoever sins sexually, sins against their own body. 19 Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own; 20 you were bought at a price. Therefore honor God with your bodies. (1 Cor 6:18-20, NIV)

Rather, I strike my body and make it my slave – lest after I have preached to others, I myself will not be disqualified [ἀδόκιμος | adokimos]. (1 Cor 9:27, AT)





8 For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—9 not by works, so that no one can boast. 10 For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do. (Eph 2:8-10, NIV)





And this is the will of him who sent me, that I shall lose none of all those he has given me, but raise them up at the last day. (Jn 6:39, NIV)





28 I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; no one will snatch them out of my hand. 29 My Father, who has given them to me, is greater than all; no one can snatch them out of my Father's hand. (Jn 10:28-29, NIV)





Everyone will hate you because of me, but the one who stands firm to the end will be saved. (Mk 13:13, NIV)





20 As for what was sown on the rocky ground, this is the one who hears the message and quickly – with joy – accepts it. 21 Yet such a person has no root in themselves, but is fleeting. So, when hardship or persecution comes because of the message, that person quickly falls away [from the faith]  $[\sigma \kappa \alpha \nu \delta \alpha \lambda i \zeta \omega \mid skandaliz\bar{o}].$ (Mt 13:20-21, AT)





The Spirit clearly says that in later times some will abandon the faith and follow deceiving spirits and things taught by demons. (1 Tim 4:1, NIV)





## At that time many will turn away from the faith [σκανδαλίζω | skandalizō] and will betray and hate each other, (Mt 24:10, NIV)





19 My brothers and sisters, if one of you should wander from the truth and someone should bring that person back, 20 remember this: Whoever turns a sinner from the error of their way will save them from death and cover over a multitude of sins. (Jas 5:19-20, NIV)





Whoever says, "I know him," but does not do what he commands is a liar, and the truth is not in that person. (1 Jn 2:4, NIV)





Examine yourselves to see whether you are in the faith; test yourselves. Do you not realize that Christ Jesus is in you unless, of course, you fail the test [άδόκιμος | adokimos]? (2 Cor 13:5, NIV)



### HOLY HELPER FOR DIVINE DISCIPLINE



22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness and selfcontrol. Against such things there is no law. (Gal 5:22-23, NIV)
