



Philippians 4:12-13 NIV

12 I know what it is to be in need, and I know what it is to have plenty. I have learned the secret of being content in any and every situation, whether well fed or hungry, whether living in plenty or in want.

13 I can do all this through him who gives me strength.



Philippians 4:10 AT

I rejoiced greatly in the Lord that now, at last, you revived your concern for me. Indeed, you were concerned about [me], but had no opportunity [to show it].



Philippians 4:11 AT

Not that I am speaking out of neediness, for I have learned – whatever [circumstances] I am in – to be content.



Philippians 4:12 AT

And I know what it is to have humble means, and I know what it is to have abundance. In **any** [$\pi\tilde{\alpha}\varsigma$ | *pas*] and **all** [$\pi\tilde{\alpha}\varsigma$ | *pas*] [circumstances], I have learned the secret [of being content] – [whether] being filled or being hungry, to have abundance or neediness.



2 Corinthians 11:23-25 NIV

23 Are they servants of Christ? (I am out of my mind to talk like this.) I am more. I have worked much harder, **been in prison more frequently, been flogged more severely, and been exposed to death again and again.**

24 **Five times** I received from the Jews the **forty lashes minus one.** 25 **Three times** I was **beaten with rods,** **once** I was **pelted with stones,** **three times** I was **shipwrecked,** I spent a **night and a day** in the open sea,



2 Corinthians 11:26 NIV

I have been constantly on the move. I have been in **danger** from rivers, in **danger** from bandits, in **danger** from my fellow Jews, in **danger** from Gentiles; in **danger** in the city, in **danger** in the country, in **danger** at sea; and in **danger** from false believers.



2 Corinthians 11:27-28 NIV

27 I have **labored** and **toiled** and have often **gone without sleep**; I have known **hunger** and **thirst** and have **often gone without food**; I have been **cold** and **naked**.

28 Besides everything else, I face daily the **pressure of my concern** for all the churches.



Philippians 4:13 AT

All [$\pi\tilde{\alpha}\varsigma$ | *pas*] [this] I am
able to do through Him
who strengthens me.



Philippians 4:14 AT

Nevertheless, you have
done well to share with
[me] in my affliction.



Philippians 4:15 AT

And also, you yourselves know, Philippians, that at the first [preaching] of the gospel, when I went out from Macedonia, not one church shared with me in the matter of giving and receiving except you, alone.



Philippians 4:16 AT

For even in Thessalonica,
once and again, you sent
me [gifts] for my need.



Philippians 4:17 AT

I do not seek the gift, but
I seek the profit that is
increasing to your
account.



Philippians 4:18 AT

But I have received in full and have an abundance. I have been fully supplied, having accepted from Epaphroditus the [gifts] from you – a pleasant aroma, an acceptable sacrifice pleasing to God.



Exodus 29:18 NIV

Then burn the entire ram on the altar. It is a **burnt offering** to the **LORD [YHWH]**, a **pleasing aroma**, a food offering presented to the **LORD [YHWH]**.



Philippians 4:19 AT

And my God will fully supply every need of yours, according to His riches in glory through Christ Jesus.



Luke 6:38 NIV

Give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over, will be poured into your lap. For with the measure you use, it will be measured to you. (Lk 6:38, NIV; cf. Dt 15:10; Pr 19:17; Pr 22:9, 28:8, 27)
