LUKE 19:28 THE KING IS COMING



Then, after He said these things, He went on ahead, going up to Jerusalem. (Lk 19:28, AT)



LUKE 19:28 THE KING IS COMING



But those enemies of mine who did not want me to be king over them—bring them here and kill them in front of me." (Lk 19:27, NIV)



LUKE 19:29-31 LOOSED FOR THE LORD



29 And it came to pass: As He came near to Bethphage and Bethany, to the mountain called [the Mount of] Olives, He sent two of the disciples, 30 saying, "Go into the village in front [of you] in which, when you enter, you will find a colt that has been tied up – [a colt] which no person has ever sat upon. Untie $[\lambda \dot{\omega} \mid ly\bar{o}]$ it and bring it [here]. 31 And if someone asks, "Why are you **untying** $[\lambda \dot{\omega} | l y \bar{o}]$ [it]?" Respond in this way: "The Lord has need of it." (Lk 19:29-31, AT)



LUKE 19:29-31 LOOSED FOR THE LORD



15 The Lord then answered him, and said, Thou hypocrite, doth not each one of you on the sabbath **loose** $[\lambda \dot{\nu} \omega \mid l \nu \bar{\sigma}]$ his ox or *his* ass from the stall, and lead him away to watering? 16 And ought not this woman, being a daughter of Abraham, whom Satan hath bound, lo, these eighteen years, be **loosed** $[\lambda \dot{\omega} | ly\bar{o}]$ from this bond on the sabbath day? (Lk 13:15-16, KJV)







32 Then, after they departed, those who were sent found [it] just as He told them. 33 And as they were untying the colt, its owners [lit. lords] said to them, "Why are you untying the colt?" 34 So they said, "The Lord has need of it." (Lk 19:32-34, AT)







35 Then they brought it to Jesus, threw their cloaks on the colt, and had Jesus mount [it]. 36 And as He went along, [people] were spreading their cloaks on the road. (Lk 19:35-36, AT)



LUKE 19:35-36 CLOAKS FOR THE KING



- 12 "That's not true!" they said. "Tell us."
- Jehu said, "Here is what he told me: 'This is what the LORD [YHWH] says: I anoint you king over Israel.'"
- 13 They quickly took their cloaks and spread them under him on the bare steps. Then they blew the trumpet and shouted,
- "Jehu is king!" (2 Ki 9:12-13, NIV)



LUKE 19:35-36 DONKEY FOR THE DELIVERER



Rejoice greatly, Daughter Zion!

Shout, Daughter Jerusalem!

See, your king comes to you, righteous and victorious,

lowly and riding on a donkey,

on a colt, the foal of a donkey. (Zec 9:9, NIV)



LUKE 19:35-36 DONKEY FOR THE DELIVERER



I will take away the chariots from Ephraim and the warhorses from Jerusalem, and the battle bow will be broken.

He will proclaim peace to the nations.

His rule will extend from sea to sea

and from the River to the ends of the earth. (Zec 9:10, NIV)




LUKE 19:37-38 SINGING PSALMS FOR THE SAVIOR



37 As He was coming near – already close to the descent of the Mount of Olives – the whole multitude of disciples, rejoicing, began to praise God in a loud voice for all of the miracles that they had seen, 38 saying, "Blessed is the King who comes in the Name of the Lord! Peace in heaven and glory in the highest [heavens]!" (Lk 19:37-38, AT)








- 22 The stone the builders rejected has become the cornerstone;

(Ps 118:25-27, NIV)




LUKE 19:37-38 SINGING PSALMS FOR THE SAVIOR



A very large crowd spread their cloaks on the road, while others cut branches from the trees and spread them on the road. (Mt 21:8, NIV)







13 And all of a sudden, with the angel, there was a large number of the army of Heaven, praising God and saying: **Glory, in the Highest (Heaven)**, to God and on earth, peace among people He favors.

(Lk 2:13-14, AT)







39 Then some of the Pharisees from the crowd said to Him, "Teacher, rebuke Your disciples!" 40 And He answered and said, "I tell you, if these [disciples] keep quiet, the stones will cry out". (Lk 19:39-40, AT)

(Is 55:12, NIV)








- 10 You have plotted the ruin of many peoples, shaming your own house and forfeiting your life.

LUKE 19:43-44 RECOGNIZE OR BE JEOPARDIZED



43 For the days will come upon you when your enemies will set up a barricade around you, and encircle you, and close in on you from every side. 44 And they will dash you to the ground – you and your children in you. And they will not leave a stone upon a stone in you, because you did not recognize the time of your visitation [from God]. (Lk 19:43-44, AT)
